12th Grade

Mid-year grades: Will be sent to colleges/universities this month.

FAFSA: Fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid.

The U.S. Department of Education announced that student FAFSA information will not be sent to schools until March. Therefore, Financial Aid packages from colleges/universities may not be received by students until April.

FAFSA can also be used by universities to award *private scholarships, grants, and work-study or loans* even if you may not qualify for financial aid.
