- Option 3: Create an historical song that details their life or an important moment in their life
- Option 4: Participate in a roundtable discussion "in character" that demonstrates your understanding of the man and his times.
- Option 5: Create a diary with 30 journal entries that might have been written by this character, and which reflects upon an important turning point or crisis in his life.

- 2) The final product is due January 4th.
