If you successfully complete the assignments below on time, you will receive up to 3 extra credit points on your marking period grade. These activities are optional, and can only help you. Our theme is art through the ages.

GUIDELINES

1. Choose **TWO** of the following time periods/ cultures that we have studied in this course:
 - a. Ancient Egypt
 - b. Greco-Roman
 - c. Middle Ages/ Gothic
 - d. European Renaissance
 - e. Byzantine Empire
 - f. African Kingdoms
 - g. Asian Dynasties
2. Go to the Metropolitan Museum of Art* and choose **one piece of art to analyze and evaluate from each of your two chosen time periods/ cultures**. Also select a third piece of art that is modern to analyze and evaluate.
3. Go to the school library and get three sources that will give you historical background related to your chosen artwork.
4. Complete a source evaluation sheet (next page) for each source by **May 5th**
5. Write a 500 word essay in which you analyze your three pieces of art and compare and contrast them.
6. Your final product is due **May 27th**

All deadlines and all criteria must be met in order in order to participate and receive any credit.
